Most important functions in companies and organisations	<p>Professor Alfred Büllesbach attended the Institute of Legal Philosophy and Legal Informatics at the University of Munich until the end of February 1979. He was regional data protection officer for the State of Bremen until August 1990, when he moved to debis Systemhaus to head up the areas of privacy, DP security, law and contracts.</p> <p>Today, Professor Büllesbach works as Group data protection officer for DaimlerChrysler AG, with responsibility for the company's subsidiaries around the world.</p> <p>Professor Büllesbach is Professor of Applied IT/Legal Informatics at the University of Bremen and has been involved with technical, organisational, societal and legal issues relating to IT and communication technology for more than two decades. His specific focus is on the integration of security requirements and the organisation of business processes. He is particularly interested in aligning the requirements of data processing security, quality assurance and privacy into one integrated concept. Professor Büllesbach has published his thoughts on these areas in a number of specialised journals.</p> <p>He is Chairman of the German Society for Law and IT (DRGI e.V.).</p>
